**NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE WORKS**  
**A38 NB between the A61 Alfreton and the M1 J28**

I'm writing to let you know that we will be carrying out noise improvement works along the A38 Northbound carriageway at Broadmeadows, Alfreton. Our work includes the installing of a new noise fence along this section of our network. The fence will benefit the local community by reducing noise levels.

To minimise disruption to our customers, we'll work overnight while the road is less busy. This will also ensure that our road network is as free-flowing as possible during the day for supermarket deliveries, delivery of medical supplies, healthcare staff travelling to where they are needed the most, and patients travelling to hospitals without delay.

**When will the work take place?**

Work is due to start **on Monday 19 October 2020** and is scheduled for completion by **early December 2020**.

**How will the work affect traffic?**

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and customers, we will need to close the A38 Northbound carriageway between the A61 Alfreton up to the M1 J28 throughout the duration of the scheme. These closures will be overnight from **8pm to 6am, Monday to Friday**.

During the closures we'll put in place a diversion route, which we've agreed with the Local Authority. The carriageways will remain open outside of our working hours.

Whilst the works take place, we will also require a daytime speed limit to be in place for safety reasons.

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

## Maintaining safety during Covid-19

We are working hard to maintain the road network and are prioritising critical operational activities. This will help ensure that life-saving medicine, equipment, supplies and healthcare staff can travel to where they're needed most.

All our sites have strict safeguarding measures, in line with Public Health England guidance, to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and none of our sites are open to the public. All construction projects are closely monitored, and the situation is kept under constant review.
